Sub: Request to allow to own both four wheeler and two wheeler against O.O.No.ONGC/ER/CP/ALL/012
Cl. No.11 Reimbursement of Insurance charges under CMRE scheme.

Respected Sir,

WE are writing this letter to bring to your attention a matter regarding the reimbursement of insurance charges for vehicles under CMRE Scheme. As per order, an employee can only receive reimbursement of Insurance for one vehicle. In case an employee owns both a two-wheeler and a four-wheeler, while applying for reimbursement for the four-wheeler, he is required to provide an undertaking stating that he does not own a two-wheeler. If the employee own a two-wheeler, then he is only eligible to apply for vehicle insurance reimbursement for the two-wheeler and not the four-wheeler.

While, we does not understand the rationale behind this order clause of Insurance reimbursement. We would like to highlight the importance of owning both a two-wheeler and a four-wheeler in today's world. A two-wheeler is not just a luxury, but a necessity. It comes in handy for carrying out urgent tasks or for domestic usage without consuming much time and fuel, as compared to a four-wheeler. It is not feasible for an individual to disown a two-wheeler in today's fast-paced world.

Hence, we are writing this letter to request you to reconsider the clause of reimbursement of insurance and allow employees to own both a two-wheeler and a four-wheeler while applying for reimbursement of insurance charges for the four-wheeler. This will benefit employees who own both vehicles and also ensure that they have insurance coverage for their two wheeler on their own.

We are sure you understand the convenience and necessity of owning a two-wheeler, and we hope you will take this into consideration and do the needful action.
